On Themselves...

- 89% know their students better
- 77% respect their students more
- 65% are more understanding of misbehavior
- 61% are better able to manage misbehavior**

- 72% had enough space for Daily Rap circle format
- 49% had better behaved students**
- 39% had more attentive students children

Of Daily Rap...

- 75% students actively engaged during Daily Rap
- 73% students allow everyone to speak & be heard
- 69% students generating their own topics
- 64% students resolve issues during Daily Rap**

On their Students...

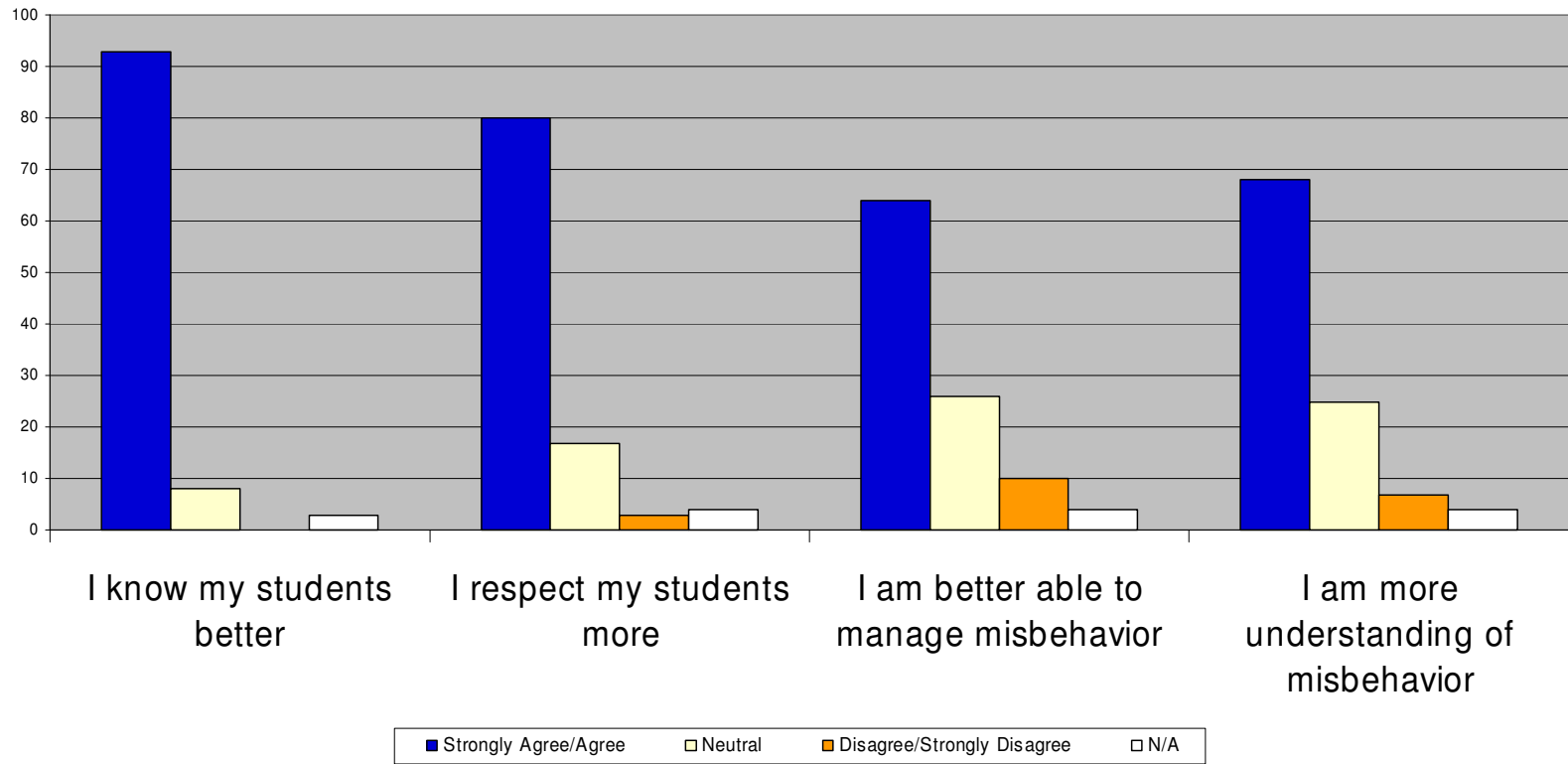
- 64% respect teachers/staff more**

- 26% had parents see positive changes in their

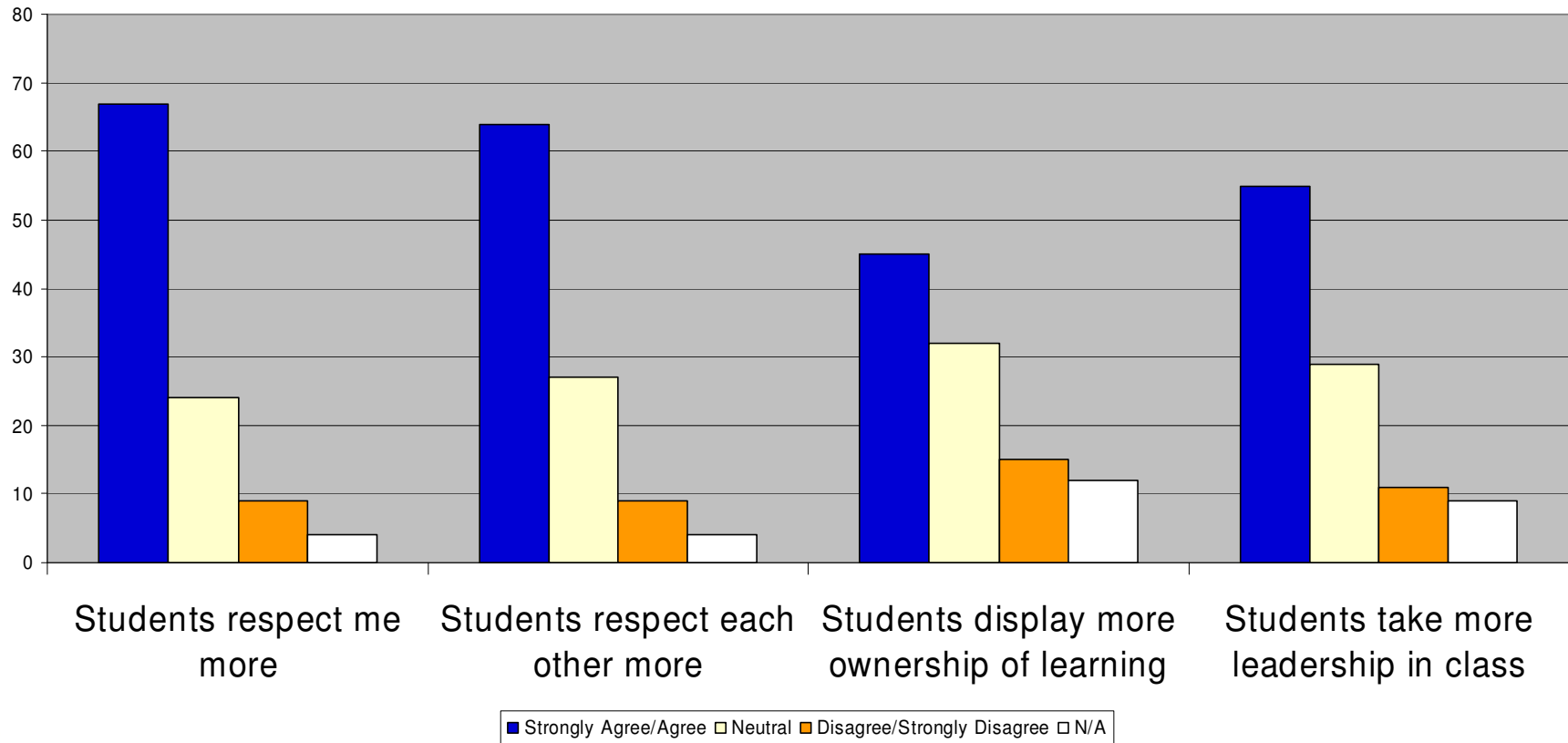


Impact of Daily Rap on Teacher/Clinician



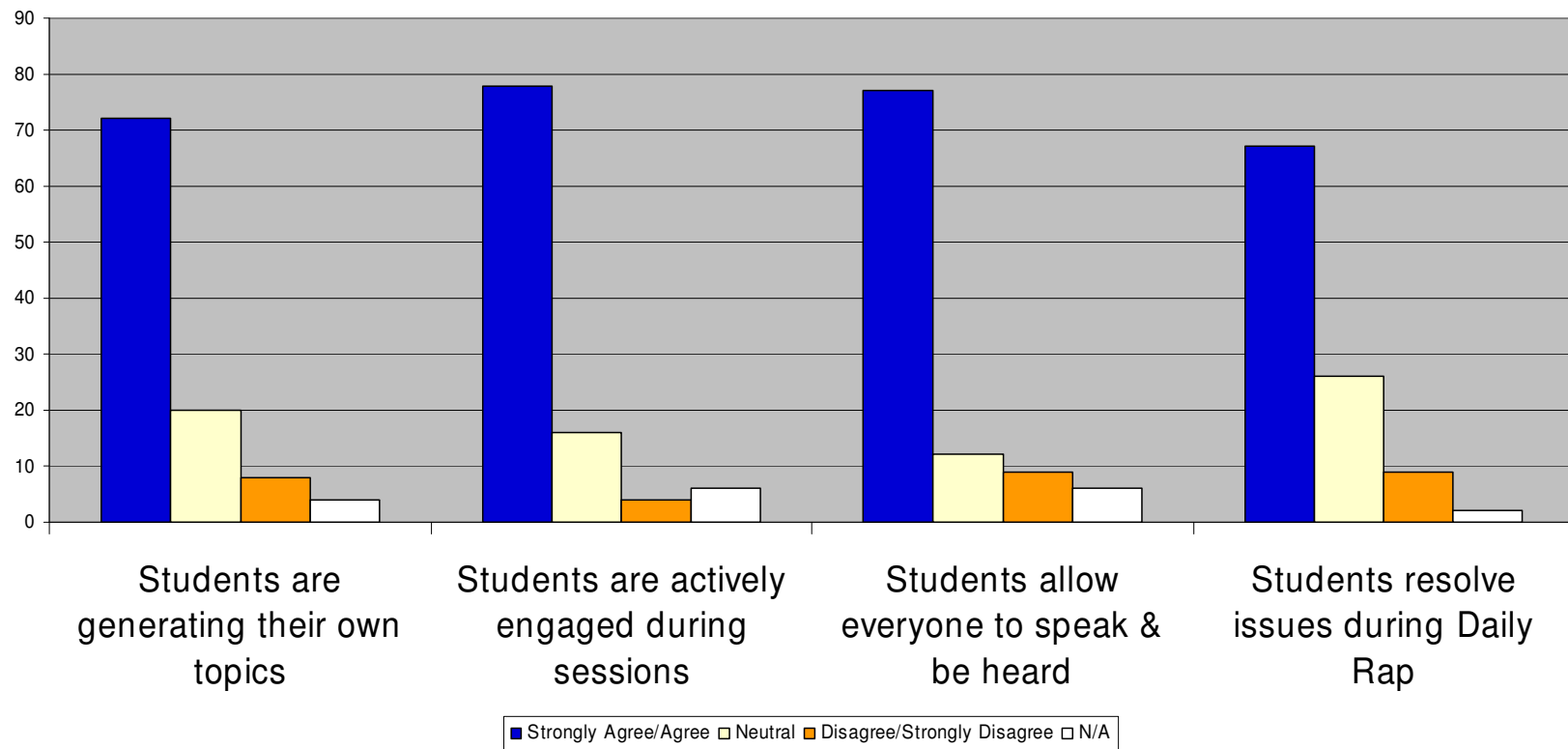


Impact of Daily Rap on Students



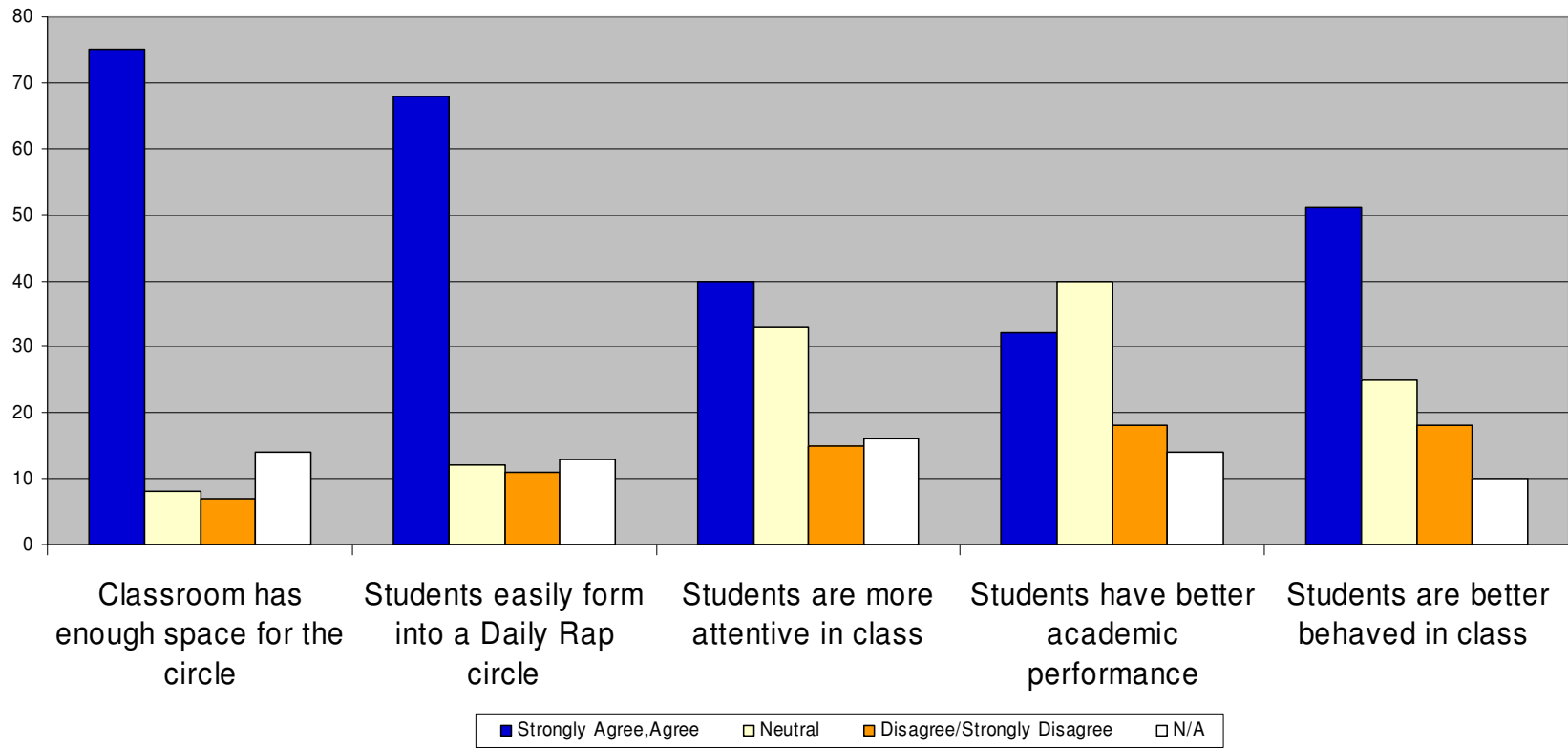


Daily Rap Empowers Students



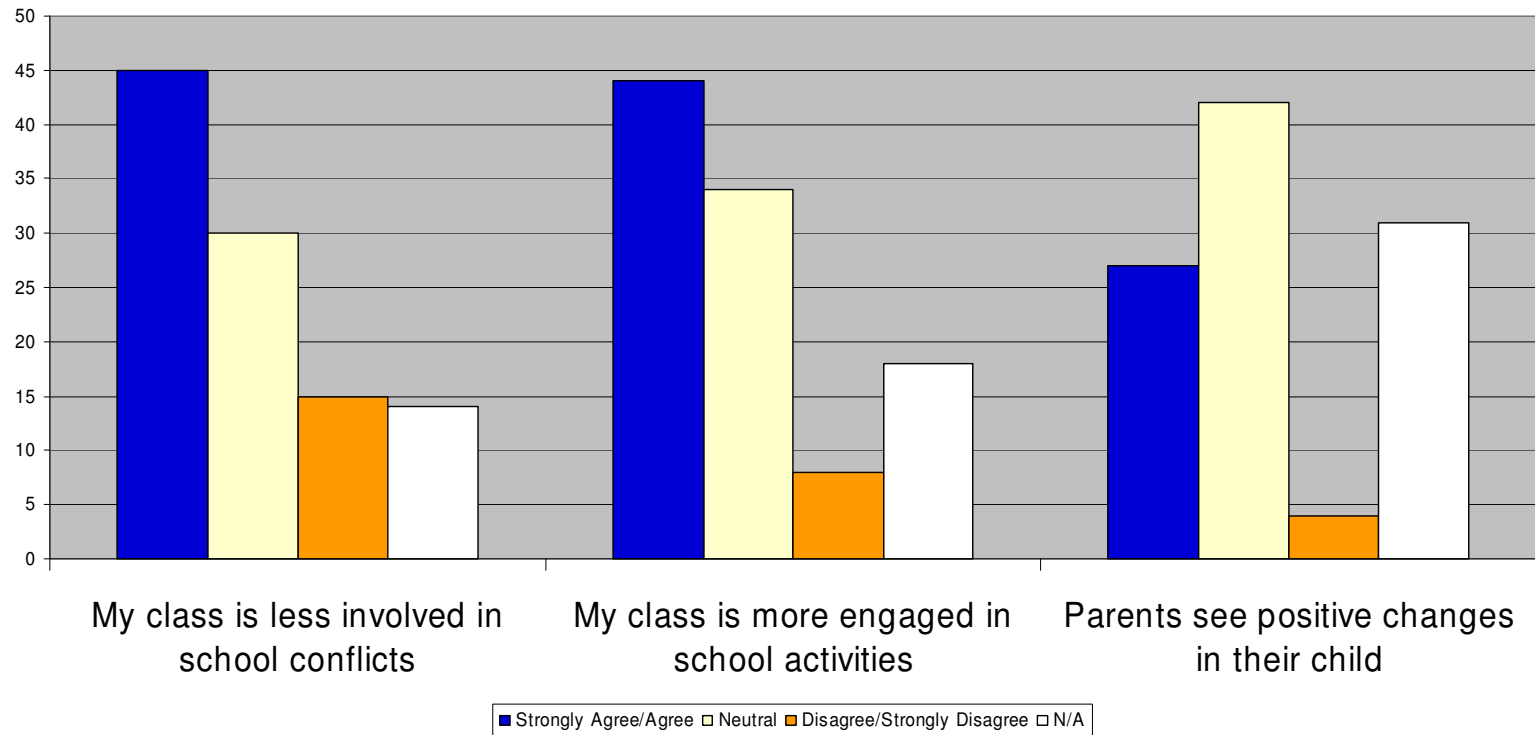


Impact of Daily Rap on Classroom

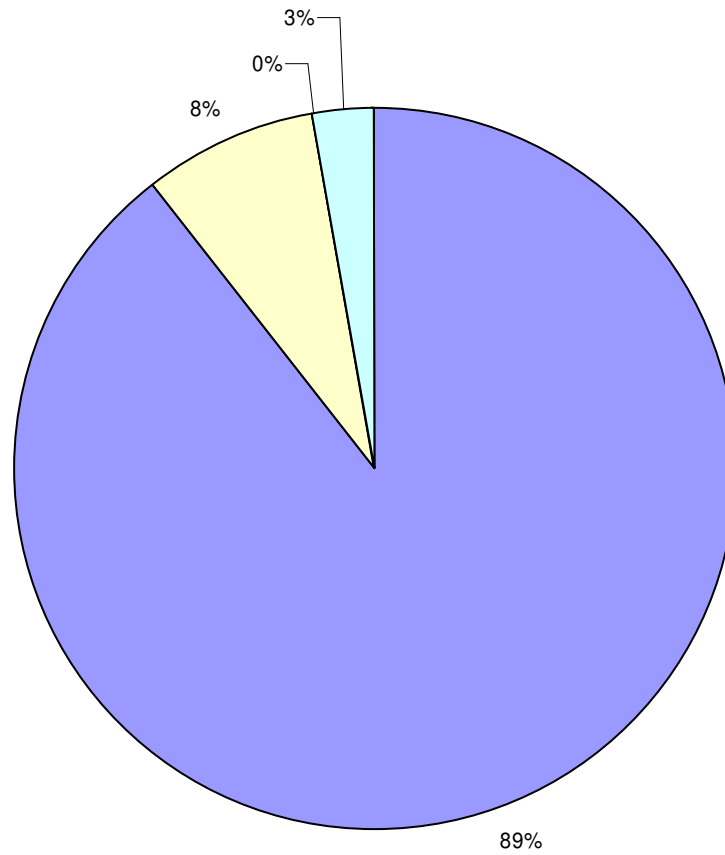

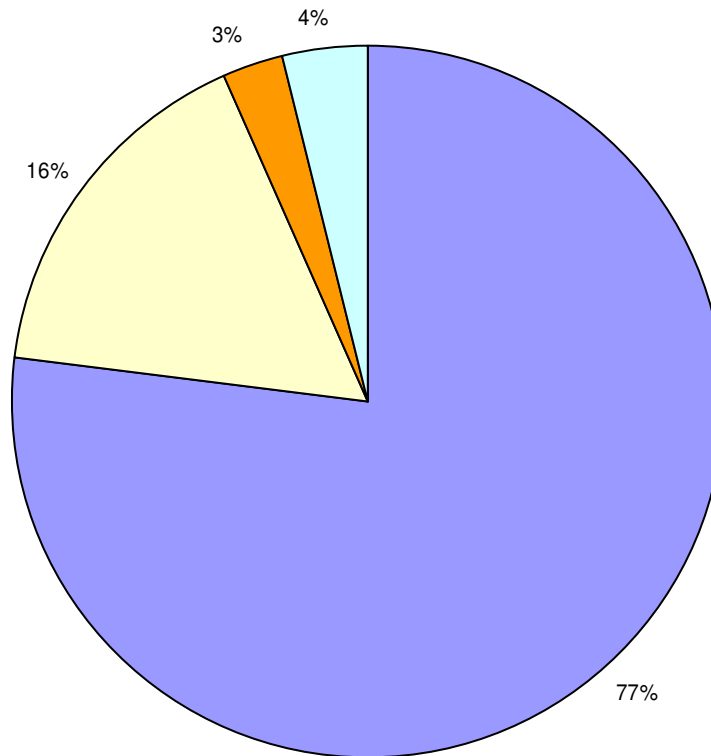

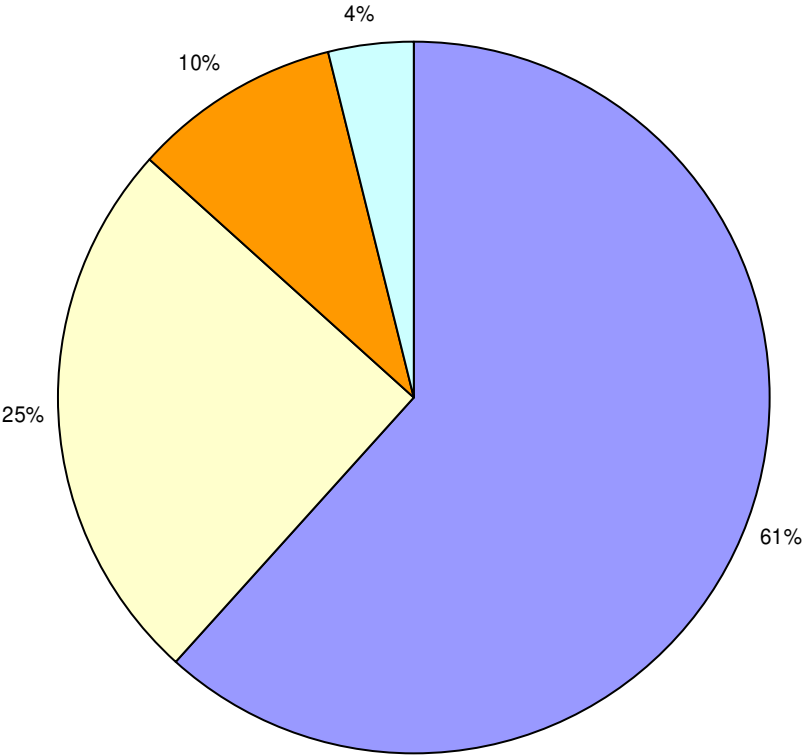

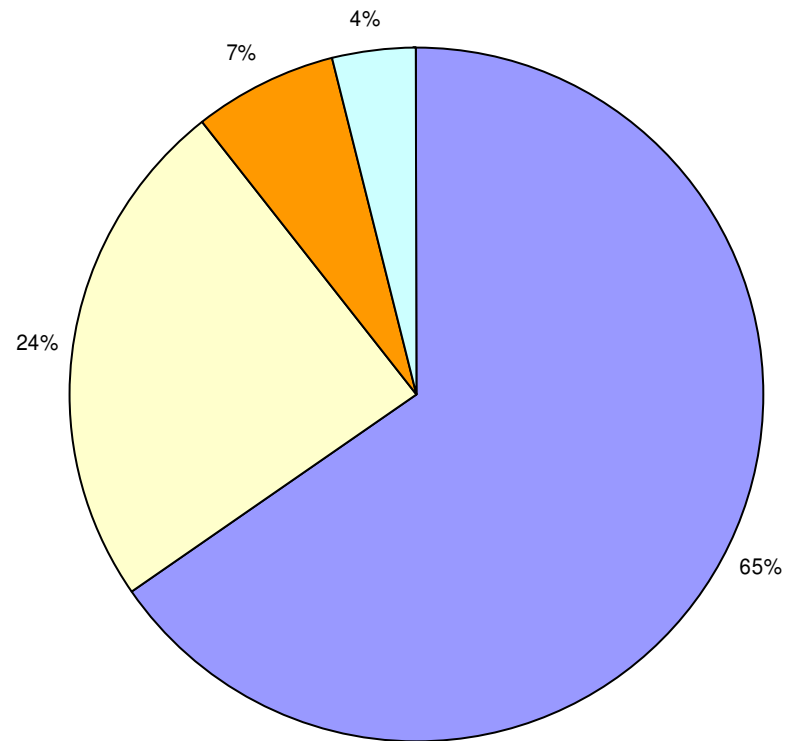

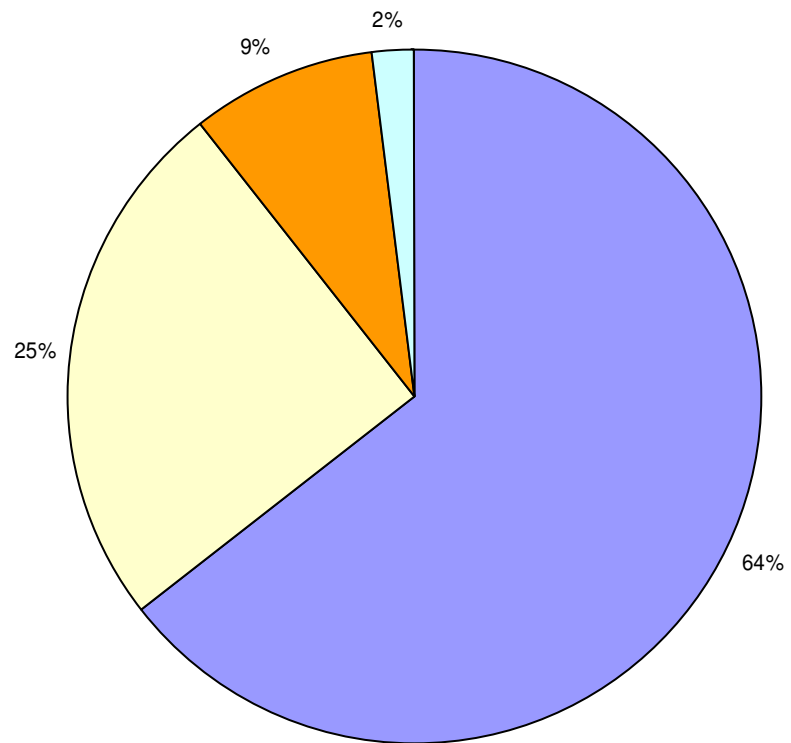

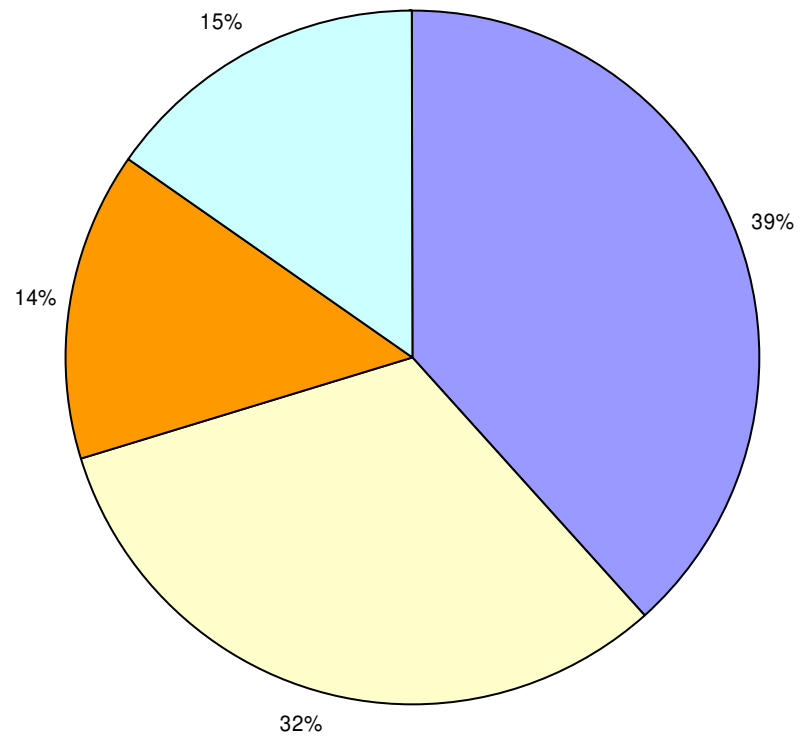


Students resolve issues during Daily Rap



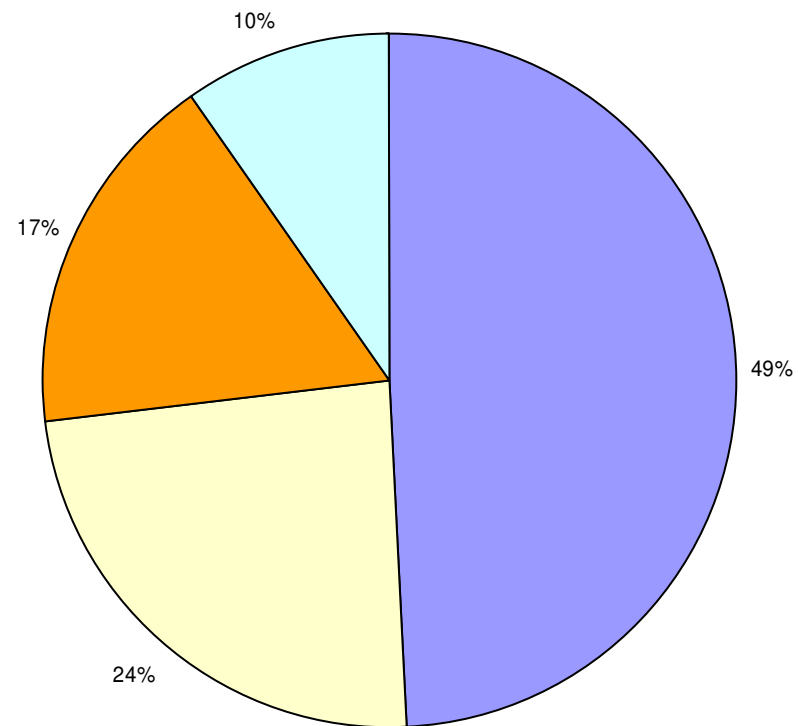

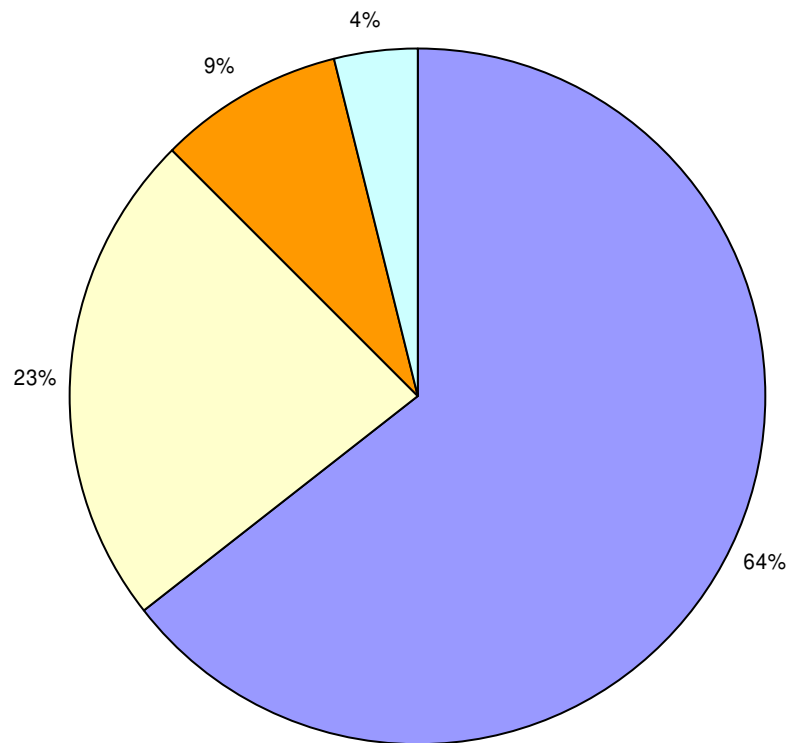

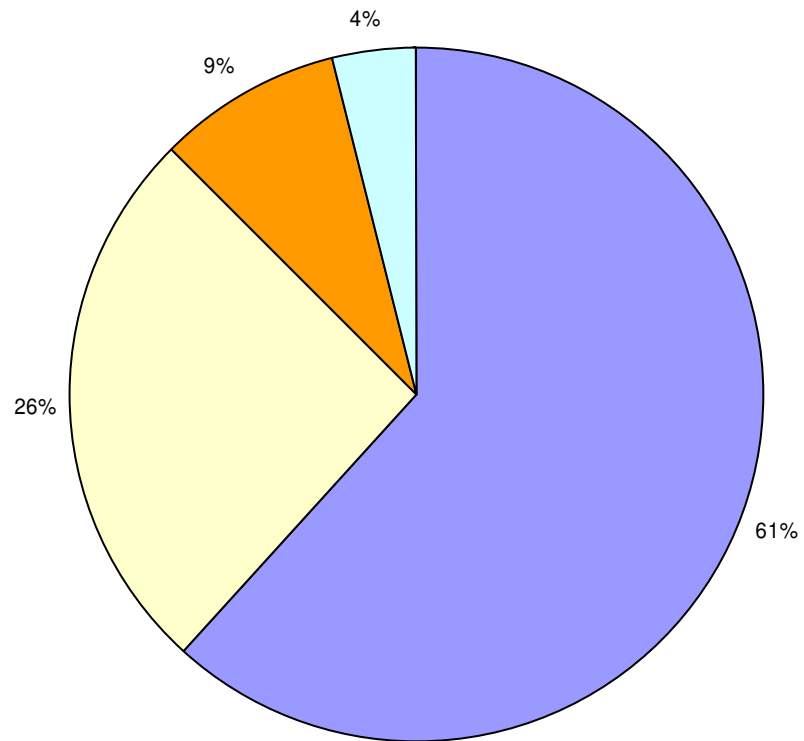

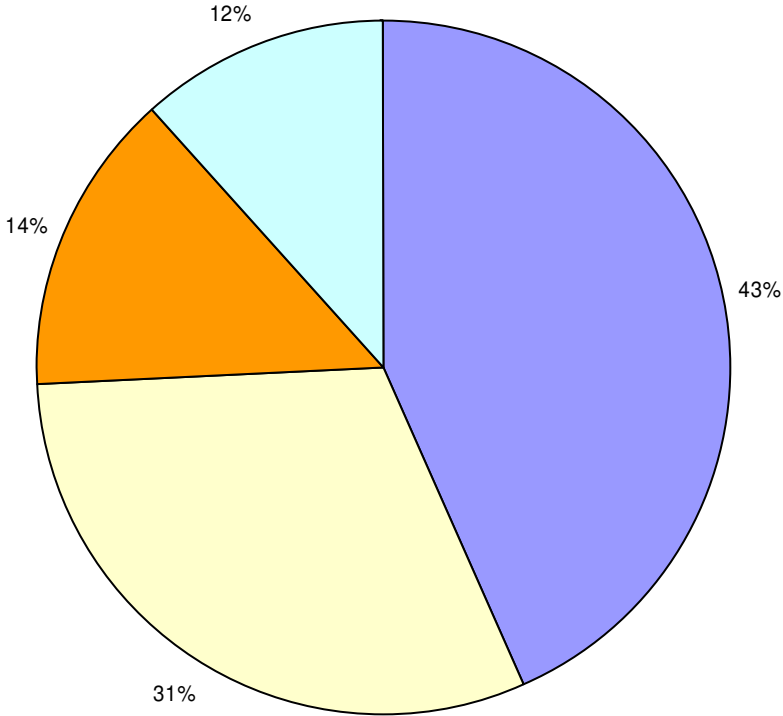

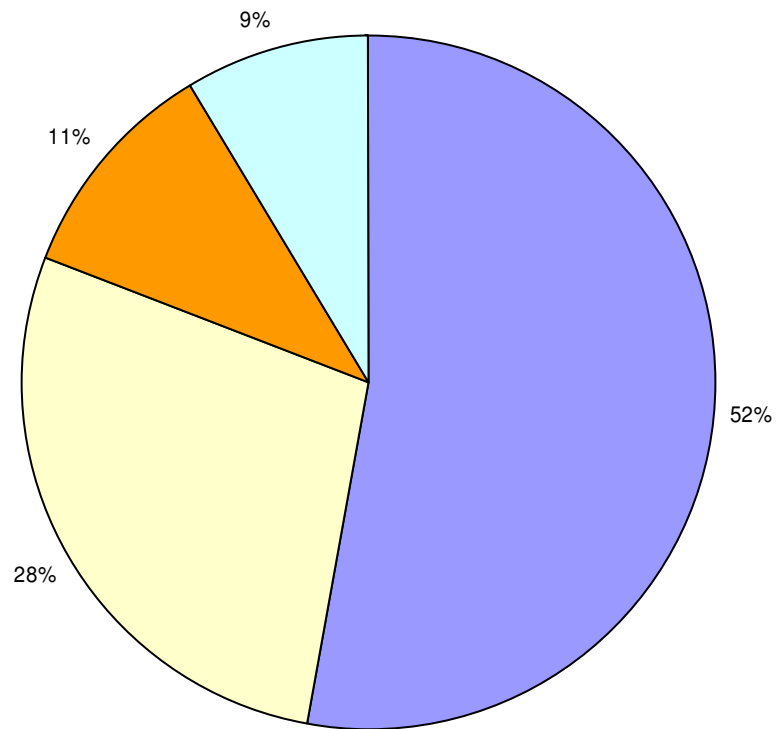

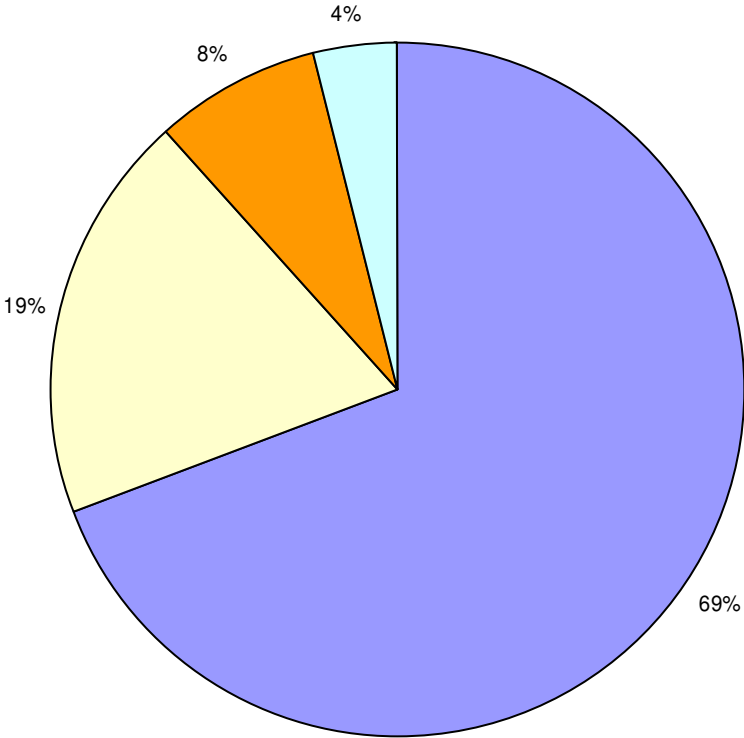

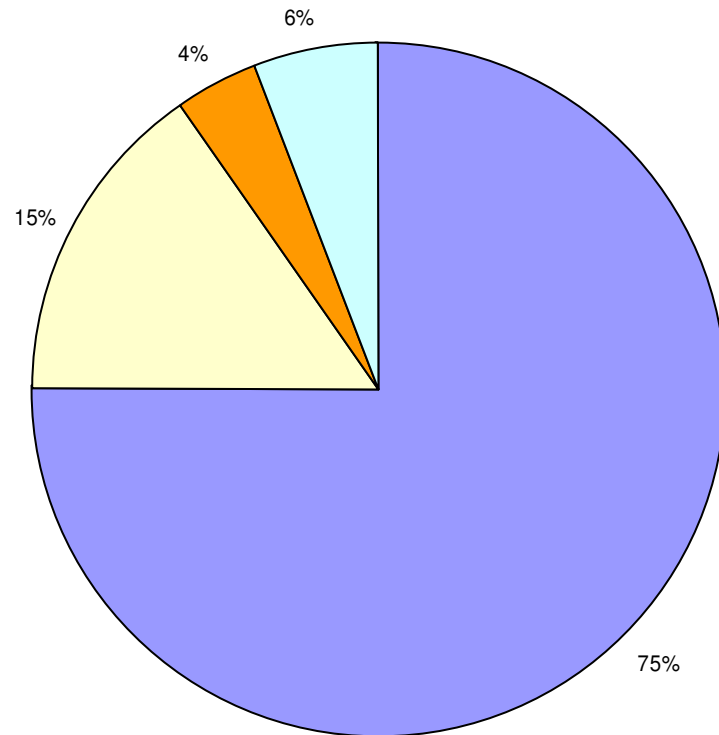

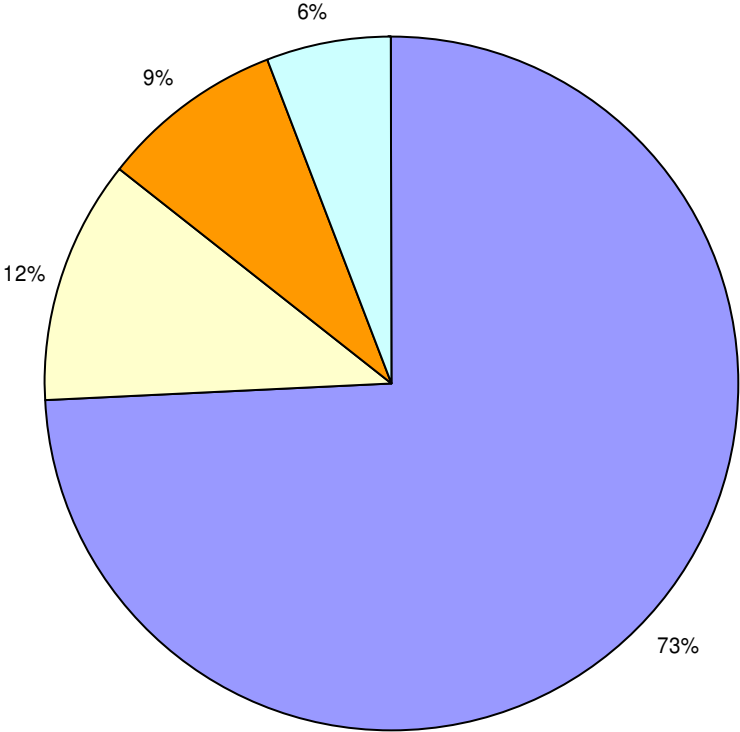

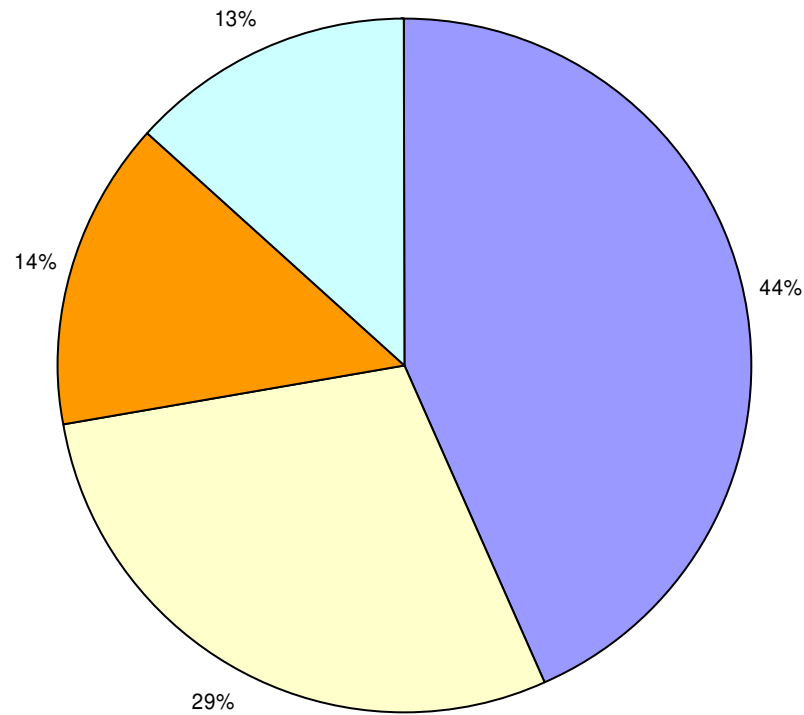

My class has fewer office referrals



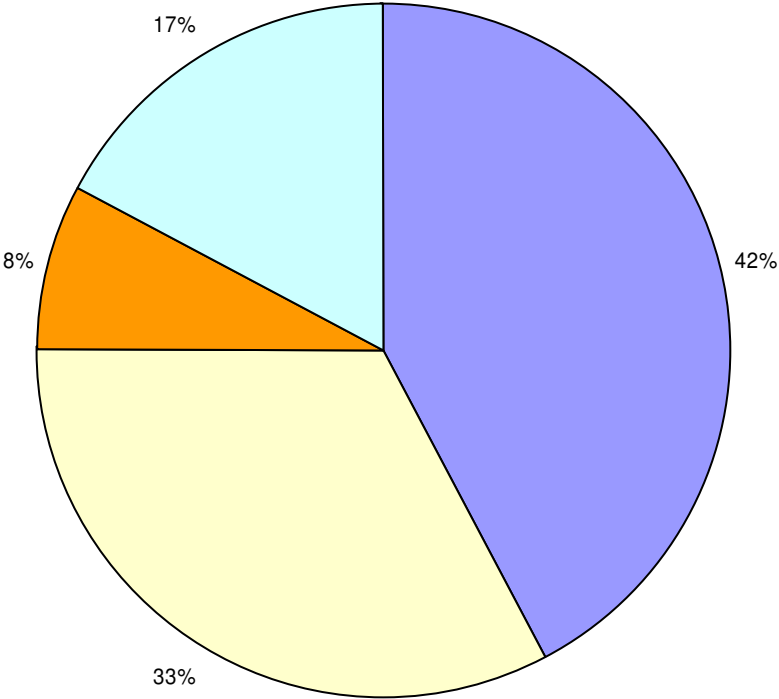

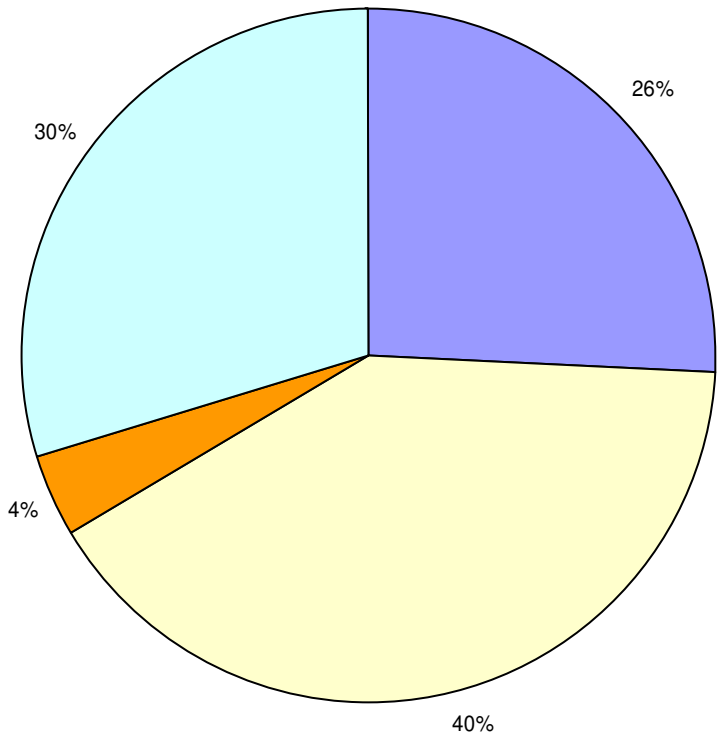
